Subject: What About The Holy Ghost?

The Holy Ghost is the third part of God. It is the third person in the Trinity. When you are born again, you are born of the Holy Ghost. This means the Holy Ghost conceives a new person in you who is Christ. The Holy Ghost makes you a new creature in Christ. The Holy Ghost then becomes a permanent part of your life. It becomes your friend, associate, and teacher, source of strength, your guide, and protector from things that will harm you.

The Holy Ghost will never leave you as long as you desire to obey the word of God. There is no power in all existence that is greater than the power of the Holy Ghost. When you are filled with the Holy Ghost, you have nothing to ever worry about again The Holy Ghost can control the minds of other people that you might have dealings with to make them do things that would be for your best interest. Of all the things you might think that you want in life, you will want nothing more than being filled with the Holy Ghost when you learn of the benefits that it offers.

Subject: Greater Is He That Is In The Saved Person Than He That Is In The World:

You will not have power to live right unless you are filled with the Holy Spirit. The human nature was given unto the power of sin and death through Adam. The human nature is under bondage to sin unless the Holy Spirit sets it free. The Holy Spirit gives power to the human nature that is greater than the power that brought it into bondage of sin. All the powers of the world are no match for the power of the Holy Spirit. Listen to I John 4:4:

Verse 4 - Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

Many Christians today know very little about the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third part of God that generates power to those who receive the teachings of the word of God. It is the Holy Spirit that gives you the new-birth. The Holy Spirit will only honor the teachings of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit has infinite and immeasurable power. No source of energy in all existence is greater than the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is more intelligent than we can imagine. The Holy Spirit is never too late or incapable of doing anything. The Holy Spirit's ability to accomplish things is unlimited. It has infinite ability and knowledge.

The Holy Spirit makes no mistakes and has no weaknesses. It is not deterred by time or distance. It is everywhere and has knowledge of everything that is happening at the same time. The sun has to listen to the Holy Spirit and darkness cannot limit its visibility. It is the third part of God and the powers in all existence cannot stand against its functions. When you are born again of the Spirit of God, nothing can withstand the power of the Holy Spirit and make you commit sin.

Subject: More About The Holy Ghost (St. John 14:26):

You learn about the Holy Ghost from the word of God. The Holy Ghost does not reveal itself by any source of information except what the word of God teaches (St. John 16:13). The word of God and the Holy Ghost are one. Though they may be two members of the Trinity, they are one in administration. This means they would be in support of one another and are never contrary to one another.

When you hear the gospel that Jesus taught, you are hearing the Holy Ghost also. The Holy Ghost is God's Spirit that He wants to give to a sinner that is willing to repent. When God gives a person the Holy Ghost, it means that God will be living in the person. The only way that we can be saved from sin is that God has to live in us. Sin cannot trespass the presence of God, so God secures our souls by giving us the Holy Ghost to live in us. When the Holy Ghost is in us, it will guide, counsel, instruct, and lead us through life.

The Holy Ghost is a spiritual teacher that gives you the ability to comprehend the knowledge of God. Without the Holy Ghost, it will be impossible to understand the knowledge of God. When a person decides to obey the word of God, the Holy Ghost will come down and broaden their capacity to understand the word of God. Fire from the Holy Ghost burns up your desire to commit sin (St. Matthew 3:11), and gives you power to withstand the evil things of the world.

When the devil tempts you to commit sin, the Holy Ghost will cause you to resist the temptation. The Holy Ghost is the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus that will make you free from the law of sin and death (Romans 8:2-3). For what your human ability could not do, even though you knew it was wrong, God sent His own

Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh. This was so that the righteousness of the word of God might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Subject: The Holy Ghost Only Teaches Spiritual Knowledge To A Spiritual Mind:

Have you ever heard a person tell a joke and very few people laughed and later after a minute or so most of the people laughed. It wasn't that the joke was not funny, but that most of the people didn't catch it until after a minute or so. This is the same way it is with your spiritual eyes when it comes to understanding the word of God. Your spiritual eyes are the eyes of your understanding. You can't catch the meaning of a lot of things that the word of God teaches unless your spiritual eyes have been enlightened. You must be filled with the Holy Spirit in order for your spiritual eyes to be opened.

The natural mind cannot comprehend the knowledge of the word of God. The natural mind does not receive knowledge from God. You can only learn the things of God when you have the Spirit of God. Listen to I Corinthians 2:14, then 13:

Verse 14 - But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

The things of God are spiritually identified and understood. Only the Spirit of God can identify and understand the things of God. This is only taught by the Holy Ghost.

Verse 13 - Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

The Holy Ghost compares spiritual knowledge from God with the knowledge that a spiritual mind has been given.
