Subject: The Spirit And The Word:

Whenever you receive the word of a person, you will also receive the spirit of the person. To receive the words of a person is to believe what their words are saying. If you receive the word of God, you will also receive the Spirit of God. The Holy Spirit works in partnership with what the word of God teaches. They work in the same administration to accomplish the same purpose for all who will receive the word.

You cannot receive the word of God without receiving the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit and the word of God are one in purpose. They seek to accomplish the same purpose, which is to give salvation to those who receive them. When a person receives the word of God, there is no power on earth that can stop the Spirit of God from giving them the new-birth in Christ Jesus.

Subject: The Adoption Process:

When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, you are one with God. When this happens, the Spirit of God that comes from God will fill your temple (body) and thereby you become a part of God. Being filled with the Holy Spirit is like official adoption papers that were certified in heaven, and presented to the person on the earth to be an official spiritual child of God. You will know that this adoption process is official when your conduct is holy, because God is holy, and you can only be made holy by the Holy Spirit that God gives you.

Subject: The Adoption:

The teachings of God's word are revealed to us in parables that are based upon everyday experiences that we are familiar with. The saved people will one day live in God's kingdom. They will also inherit the earth. The world as we presently know it is in the possession of unsaved men that have rulership and authority over the wealth of the world.

In most situations of this present world, the saved people of God are servants to the wealthy men of the world. In the family of a wealthy man, his children have no more authority than his servants. When children of the wealthy families are young, they will have less authority than the servants who work for the wealthy family. When children become grown-ups, they will come into possession of the wealth of the family. So is it also with a child of God. While living in this present world, a child of God is like the children of the wealthy family until the time appointed of God the Father to give His children their inheritance. Listen to Galatians 4:1-2, and 4-7:

Verse 1 - Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

Verse 2 - But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.

God saved us from the sinful life of the world that we might be adopted into His family to receive our inheritance.

Verse 4 - But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

Verse 5 - To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Verse 6 - And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying Abba, Father.

Verse 7 - Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Subject: When We Are Saved We Become A Part Of God:

You can repent of some sins, but you cannot completely remove sin from your life, because sin abides in your nature. It is natural for humans to be sinners. When

God saves us, He changes the nature of those that He saves. Along with your repentance, there must also be a total surrenderance of your life to Christ. When you surrender your life to God, He fills you with the Holy Spirit that completely changes the human nature. The Holy Spirit then makes you to become a part of God. Everybody who goes to heaven will be a part of God, because he or she would have received life by the Holy Spirit.

All citizens of heaven will become a part of the third member of the Trinity, which is the Holy Spirit. To be filled with the Spirit of God is to be one with God. Christ is the head of the church. The Spirit of God that comes from God fills our bodies (temple) and thereby we become a part of God.

Subject: The Spirit Of God Can Find A Person Who Obeys The Word Of God:

When you obey from the heart the gospel of Jesus Christ, you can be saved. It was disobedience that separated us from God, and obedience can bring us back to God. You are born again by obeying from the heart the teachings of the word of God. The word of God has power to convert your carnal nature to a spiritual nature. The Spirit of God can find a person who desires to obey the word of God and will impregnate the person's mind with the power of God converting the person from a sinner to a saint. When you are made free from sin, you become the servants of righteousness. Listen to Romans 6:18:

Verse 18 - Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

Just as you yield your body members to commit sin, when you become a servant of righteousness, you will yield your body members to righteousness unto holiness. When you were a servant of sin, you were free from righteousness, which means you couldn't do right. When you were a servant of sin, you were in bondage to sin. You cannot be a servant of God and a servant of sin at the same time. You have to be free from sin to be a servant of God.
