God will not save you after you die.



God's hearing is reciprocal. If you hear God, he will hear you. There are prerequisites for being able to pray to God. Unless we have met the qualifications to be able to pray, then God will not hear our prayers.

The first and most important requirement is that our lives must be free from sin. If there are things that we are doing wrong, God will reveal it to us. Nevertheless, God does not hear a sinner's prayers no matter how much a sinner thinks that God has given him or her many material blessings. His sun shines on the just as well as the unjust (St. Matthew 5:45).

St. John 9:31 reads, "Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth". Along with a life that is free from sin, one must present prayers to God that are free from sin also. If a person regards iniquity in his heart, God will not hear their prayers (Psalm 66:18).

If a person has hatred or ill feelings in his or her heart towards another person, God will not hear their prayers. Prayers to God must be free from greed, selfishness, emulations and revenge. A person's prayers should be centered around petitions for other people rather than one's self. (*Continued on page 5*)

The Good News Preacher's Message To All

Only The Holy Spirit Can Replace The Sinful Nature:

When humans are born in sin, it is sin that works in them controlling their lives and causing them to be separated from God. Listen to Romans 7:17, "Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me". We cannot remove our sins. Our sins can only be removed when we surrender our lives to Christ. When people desire to have joy and pleasures in life, and they are sinners, their sins will be a part of their pleasures.

Their sins will cause them to enjoy such things as fornication, adultery, liquor drinking, and illegal drug usage.

When sin is in the nature of humans, it causes them to seek for sinful pleasures to satisfy the cravings of the sinful human nature. Everybody is seeking happiness, but unless the Holy Spirit saves a person from the desires of the sinful nature, they will be deceived by their own sinful desires.

When you are filled with the Holy Spirit, it burns up the nature of sinful desires and gives you the divine nature of God (St. Matthew 3:11). When you have the nature of God, the Holy Spirit will give you joy. You will then be able to enjoy the fruit of the Holy Spirit that will cause you to rejoice in the Spirit. Joy from the Holy Spirit is holy joy, which is sin-free. Such joy comes from heaven.

The sinful pleasures of the flesh come from the earth, which is contrary to the joy from heaven. Listen to Galatians 5:17, "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would".

When you have a sinful nature, you are in the flesh and you cannot rejoice in the Spirit, because the fruit of the Spirit are contrary to sinful desires of the flesh. Listen to Galatians 5:19-21: "Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God".

When you have the Holy Spirit, you can rejoice with the fruit of the Spirit, which are as follows: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law" (Galatians 5:22-23).

The New Life In Christ

- Verse 32 -And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

The new man causes you to be kind when others mistreat you. Never worry about people who mistreat you, because the scriptures teach us in Galatians 6:7 and 9:


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The Purity Club Champion of Champions

One Purity Club activity, the Sword Drill, is a scripture-finding exercise. The participants stand in line and they are asked to find scriptures, responding to this call - "Thumbs to the backs of your Bibles, draw swords one two, find St. Matthew 5:48", for example.

In a matter of seconds, ten or less, participants attempt to find the scripture called. The first to locate it says, "I have it" stepping out of line quickly with their trigger (index) finger pointing to the verse called. The scorekeeper checks the scriptures and if found correctly, the individual gets one point. If a person announces that they have found the scripture called, and they actually have not, they lose a point. The person who successfully finds three scriptures first earns three points, and is the winner or champion of that particular round.

At the end of each month all winners of the weekly sword drill rounds compete in a Champion of Champions round. The winner of that round becomes the monthly. "Champion of Champions" and receives a prize. "Thumbs To The Backs Of Your Bibles, Draw Swords, ONE, TWO!"
